SALSA MAKING WORKSHOP

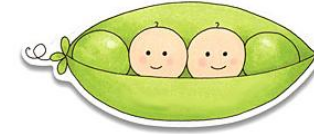
AGES 16 -ADULT, \$15 EACH- SEPT. 18TH, 9:00-Noon or 1:00-4:00 pm
